

2022 Bridger Trail Mid-Range High Power Rifle Match

LOCATION: Worland Shooting Complex. Starting in Worland on Hwy 20 go to West River Road (WYO 433) and go north approx. 1/3 of a mile then turn left onto 15 Mile Road at Washakie County Fairgrounds. Follow the road, moving toward the landfill. Take the paved road up the hill to the right (northerly), driving past the gravel pits. After a few minutes you should see the Worland Shooting Complex sign on the right. Move on to the gravel road to the range. GPS to front gate: N 45 deg. 49.193 min, W 108 deg. 41.994 min.

MATCH DATE: Sunday September 18th, 2022.

TIME: Registration opens at 0700 & closes at 0745. First round down range at 0800 MDT

TYPE OF MATCH: CMP Approved/Registered.

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are limited to 18 competitors. Advanced entries are encouraged to assist with squading, but not required. Any individual familiar with safe firearms practices, and who supports the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms may come and compete. SAFETY Hearing and Eye Protection is required for all competitors during the match. “Empty Chamber Indicator” (ECI) is required for all firearms used during the match and may be purchased for \$2.00 at registration. All shooting will be done in the prone position, (laying down) No Muzzle Brakes, Compensators, or Sound Suppressors!

FIREARMS: As per the CMP Rules Book listed above, Service Rifles, (Rule 4.1.1 & 4.1.2 & 4.1.3 & 4.1.4 & 4.1.6), Match Rifles (Rule 4.1.5), F-Class Rifles, (Rule 4.1.7 & 4.1.8), Tactical Rifles, (4.1.9).
Hunting Rifles. Most any normal Safe Hunting Rifle and Sight, with any reasonable support. Note, Hunting Rifle Category will only fire 10 rds per match (30 rds total)

NOTE: Competitors may fire different rifles in this event, but they must use the same rifle in all individual matches, unless that rifle should become disabled.

AMMUNITION: Tracer, incendiary, explosive ammunition prohibited. All safe ammunition allowed.

CLASSIFICATION: The CMP classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

DUTIES: All matches will be squadded. All competitors will be expected to shoot, and score, as well as perform pit duties, and other task required to conduct the match.

TARGETS: 600 Yard MR-1, for everyone, except the F-Class competitors will use F-Class targets. The Shot Marker Electronic Target Systems will be used. But scores will be recorded on the competitors score card. The Competitors score card will be used to determine match winners, not the Electronic Target Systems Records.

MATCH FEES: Everyone will pay \$10. (Except for Miss Patti, especially if she brings cookies)

COURSE OF FIRE:

MATCH 1: 600 yards prone, Unlimited Sighters, then 20 shots for record, in a time limit of 25 minutes.

MATCH 2: 600 yards prone, Unlimited Sighters, then 20 shots for record, in a time limit of 25 minutes.

MATCH 3: 600 yards prone, Unlimited Sights, then 20 shots for record, in a time limit of 25 minutes.

Note: Competitors using hunting rifles will fire only 10 shots for record in each match

MATCH 4: Aggregate of matches 1 through 3.

SIGHTING SHOTS: Unlimited sighting shots will be allowed in all separate matches. It is the shooters responsibility to let the score keeper know when the shooter will go for record.

AWARDS: Everyone can engage in all the bragging rights they care to enjoy until their hearts are content.

Note: Everyone who uses cmp authorized firearms and shoots the match in accordance with CMP rules will have their scores forwarded to the CMP.

RANGE FACILITIES: Dry Camping space is available at the WSC Range. No water, No power. Call Nick if ya need to camp at the range. 307 347 8852.
